2nd ANNUAL EDUCATION OF THE FUTURE FESTIVAL 25 SHORT FILMS IN COMPETITION THIS YEAR

Montreal, May 2, 2019 – Lab Québec Cinéma will participate in the **Education of the Future Festival**, organized by its partner **Youth Fusion**. The event, which promotes staying in school, will take place from **May 28 to 31** at Olympic Stadium. Among the festival's many activities, at its annual gala, the festival will announce the films selected for the **CLIP** film competition. An initiative of **Youth Fusion**, the project promotes students retention by organizing film workshops for young people, culminating in the making of a short film. There are 25 films in the running for the prize to be awarded by **Québec Cinéma** on May 29.

FILM WORKSHOPS TO KEEP KIDS IN SCHOOL

Nearly 4,000 young people are expected to attend the second annual **Education of the Future Festival**. On-site, **Lab Québec Cinéma** will participate in the screening of the films in the cinema program **CLIP** competition. A partner of this program, the Lab handles the awareness and education components of the project by running film workshops. The students received guidance from industry professionals at the various phases of their project. In all, **20 workshops** have been given in high schools around the province.

"We are proud that Lab Québec Cinéma is part of a project fighting to reduce the dropout rate, while also showcasing our artists. Thanks to Youth Fusion cinema program, more than 600 young people from some 30 Quebec high schools had the opportunity to meet film professionals. I would like to take this opportunity to applaud the work done by Youth Fusion and by the many professionals involved in making this project a success," said François Lemieux, director of the Tournée and Lab Québec Cinéma.

This year, more than 30 shorts were made on the theme of "Our Universe." At the conclusion of a selection process conducted by the high schools, 25 of the films were chosen for screening on May 29. At the end of the day, a jury of professionals will name the winners of several awards. The film that stands out according to Quebec Cinema's criteria will receive the Prix Québec Cinéma.

"Year after year, the partnership between Youth Fusion and Québec Cinéma grows stronger, and together we are improving the quality of our projects. On behalf of all the young people who participate in our film program, and on behalf of the people whose lives are changed in large or small ways by the films: thank you very much. This support is essential to the development of young film professionals, and to the production of the projects," said Rose Lyndsay Daudier, executive director of Youth Fusion.
